Format:

Write the assignment number in the upper right hand corner. The assignment number is the date the assignment is given

Put your name and period number just below it.

Collaboration:

Collaboration is permitted with the following conditions:

You are required to begin work individually. As a specific example, the initial steps of the problem solving method should be first attempted individually (definition through exploration)

The names of the collaborators should be included.

**Evaluation:**

**Quality and Effort (0-4)**

All problems attempted and worked through to conclusion

Evidence of the use of the Problem Solving method

Intermediate work and answers clearly shown

Critique

A sentence or two about your assessment of the work (i.e. difficulties—overcome or not, what you learned or need to learn)

**Workmanship (0-4)**

**Examples:**

Work easily followed

Writing is easily legible

Pencil is encouraged. Ink cross-outs may be a deduction

Units included (when applicable)

If pages are torn from a spiral notebook, edges removed)

Work that is not clear and easily followed does not get the benefit of the doubt at all. The experience is that, in the workplace, individuals who have done high quality work, but presented it haphazardly, generally have not fully rewarded for their contributions

Homework evaluations will be generally done with your team and I will collect and review the conclusions. In general, a 3 or 4 is acceptable and 1 or 2 indicates that additional effort or understanding is required.

Late work merits a maximum of 2.
