

HOW TO USE ROCKETSIM!

1. Firstly, you need to use firefox. You need to use a special version of firefox that allows the use of java; normal firefox now blocks java because everything is terrible.
2. Download "Firefox ESR." It is a special version of firefox that allows certain unsecure plugins, like java, to run. You can find it on the firefox downloads website, or just Google Firefox ESR.
3. Download the latest version of java.
4. Launch Firefox ESR. Go to the rocket simulator website (just google "NASA rocket simulator"). Copy the address of the page (it should look something like grc.nasa.gov....).
5. Go into system preferences. Open up the Java control panel.
6. Go into the security tab and click on edit site list. Add an exception and paste in the address you copied before. Make sure you paste the full link; not just grc.nasa.gov, but grc.nasa.gov/k-12/... Or whatever it is exactly.
7. Apply your changes, quit system preferences, and quit Firefox ESR.
8. Reopen Firefox ESR. Go to the rocket simulator website.
9. If it asks if you want to run the Java plugin, say yes. If it asks you if you want to enable Java in this application, say yes. Whatever it asks you, say yes.
10. You should see a white screen with the Java logo and a loading circle. Give it some time; it may take a minute or two to load.
11. It should load the rocket simulator. If it does not, double check the steps above; make sure you added the site to the java exceptions list, make sure you are running Firefox ESR and not Firefox, and make sure you have restarted Firefox ESR.
